

# OC Children's Screening Registry

## Report Definitions

### **I. Aggregate of Screening Tools:**

---

*This report provides the number of all developmental and trauma screening tools completed.*

**Total number of screenings radio dial:** child screenings will be counted in all programs where the child received a screening. This means that the child may show up in different rows for different screening tools (columns).

**Unique count radio dial:** the child will only be counted in each column in the program they had the most recent screening.

This report contains a column labeled “unique child count” which counts each child entered by the program only once in each row regardless of the number of tools completed. The row at the bottom of the report labeled “Unique Child Count in Registry” counts the child only once across the entire Registry regardless of number of organizations who have screened the child.

### **II. Aggregate of all Developmental Screening Tools:**

---

*This report provides the number of all developmental screening tools completed. This includes: ASQ-3; ASQ:SE-2; M-CHAT R/F; and PEDS only.*

**Total number of screenings radio dial:** child screenings will be counted in all programs where the child received a screening. This means that the child may show up in different rows for different screening tools (columns).

**Unique count radio dial:** the child will only be counted in each column in the program they had the most recent screening.

This report contains a column labeled “unique child count” which counts each child entered by the program only once in each row regardless of the number of tools completed. The row at the bottom of the report labeled “Unique Child Count in Registry” counts the child only once across the entire Registry regardless of number of organizations who have screened the child.

### **III. Aggregate of all Trauma Screening Tools (PEARLS):**

---

*This report provides the number of all trauma screening tools completed. This includes: PEARLS-Child (0-11) Parent/Caregiver; PEARLS- Teen (12 and up) Parent/Caregiver; and PEARLS- Teen (12 and up) Self only.*

**Total number of screenings radio dial:** child screenings will be counted in all programs where the child received a screening. This means that the child may show up in different rows for different screening tools (columns).

**Unique count radio dial:** the child will only be counted in each column in the program they had the most recent screening.

This report contains a column labeled “unique child count” which counts each child entered by the program only once in each row regardless of the number of tools completed. The row at the bottom of the report labeled “Unique Child Count in Registry” counts the child only once across the entire Registry regardless of number of organizations who have screened the child.

## IV. ASQ-3 Aggregate by lowest result in any one domain:

---

*This report provides the total number of children counted one time by the lowest score in a domain.*

**Total Screenings:** column will count all ASQ-3 screenings with the Score Result.

**Total Unique Children:** will only count the child once based on their most recent ASQ-3 screening tool Score Result, and then determined by score across domains.

## V. ASQ-3 Results by Domain:

---

*This report provides the results by each domain. The child is counted one time per domain: communication; gross motor; fine motor; problem solving; and personal/social.*

**Total Screenings:** column will count all ASQ-3 screenings with the Score Result.

**Total Unique Children:** will only count the child once based on their most recent ASQ-3 screening tool except it will be isolated within a single domain at a time.

## VI. ASQ: SE-2 Results:

---

*This report provides the total number of ASQ: SE-2 screenings by score result.*

**Total Screenings:** column will count all ASQ:SE-2 screenings with the Score Result.

**Total Unique Children:** will only count the child once based on their most recent ASQ: SE-2 screening tool.

## VII. M-CHAT R/F:

---

*This report provides a total count of M-CHAT-R/F screenings by score results. If score falls on Medium Risk, it will count the number of “Was follow-up was conducted?” and “Follow-up result”.*

**Total Screenings:** column will count and total: (1) all M-CHAT-R/F screenings with the Score Result; (2) Responses to “Was follow-up conducted?” for the screenings scoring at Medium Risk; and (3) “Follow up results” when applicable.

**Total Unique Children:** will count the child once based on their most recent M-CHAT R/F. Each child will be counted once for each section: (1) M-CHAT R/F, (2) "Was follow-up conducted?", (3) "Follow-up result".

## VIII. PEDS Results by Path:

---

*This report provides information on the total screenings within each interpretation of the PEDS tool.*

**Total Screenings:** column will count all PEDS screenings with each interpretation.  
**Total Unique Children:** the most recent PEDS interpretation will be used for each child and a child will not show up in multiple paths in this column.

## IX. PEARLS- Child (0-11) Parent/Caregiver Results

---

*This report provides total count of PEARLS- Child (0-11) Parent/Caregiver screenings by score results. Report also totals clinical assessment risk types if Part 1 score is 1-3.*

**Total Screenings:** column will count all PEARLS- Child (0-11) Parent/Caregiver screenings with the Score Result. If Part 1 score was 1-3, column will total clinical assessment risk type. If clinical assessment for a score of 1-3 is not available, the results will be listed as Clinical Assessment N/A.

**Total Unique Children:** will count the child once based on their most recent PEARLS- Child (0-11) Parent/Caregiver. Each child will be counted once for each section: (1) Low Risk (Score=0); (2) Clinical Assessment: Intermediate Risk; (3) Clinical Assessment: High Risk; (4) Clinical Assessment: N/A; (5) High Risk (Score 4+).

## X. PEARLS- Teen (12 and up) Parent/Caregiver Results

---

*This report provides total count of PEARLS- Teen (12 and up) Parent/Caregiver screenings by score results. Report also totals clinical assessment risk types if Part 1 score is 1-3.*

**Total Screenings:** column will count all PEARLS- Teen (12 and up) Parent/Caregiver screenings with the Score Result. If Part 1 score was 1-3, column will total clinical assessment risk type. If clinical assessment for a score of 1-3 is not available, the results will be listed as Clinical Assessment N/A.

**Total Unique Children:** will count the child once based on their most recent PEARLS- Teen (12 and up) Parent/Caregiver. Each child will be counted once for each section: (1) Low Risk (Score=0); (2) Clinical Assessment: Intermediate Risk; (3) Clinical Assessment: High Risk; (4) Clinical Assessment: N/A; (5) High Risk (Score 4+).

## **XI. PEARLS- Teen (12 and up) Self Results**

---

*This report provides total count of PEARLS- Teen (12 and up) Self screenings by score results. Report also totals clinical assessment risk types if Part 1 score is 1-3.*

**Total Screenings:** column will count all PEARLS- Teen (12 and up) Self screenings with the Score Result. If Part 1 score was 1-3, column will total clinical assessment risk type. If clinical assessment for a score of 1-3 is not available, the results will be listed as Clinical Assessment N/A.

**Total Unique Children:** will count the child once based on their most recent PEARLS- Teen (12 and up) Self. Each child will be counted once for each section: (1) Low Risk (Score=0); (2) Clinical Assessment: Intermediate Risk; (3) Clinical Assessment: High Risk; (4) Clinical Assessment: N/A; (5) High Risk (Score 4+).

## **XII. Outcomes on Referrals to Help Me Grow:**

---

*This report provides information on status and outcomes for referrals made to Help Me Grow per screening tool.*

**Total number of entries radio dial:** counts number of referrals per screening tool, but grouping counts by Outcome hierarchy. For example, if there is one "Connected" and one "Pending" on referrals for same child, the report shows "2" under ASQ-3 on "Connected" row, but "0" on "Pending Service" row. This is the same for the other screening tools.

**Unique count radio dial:** the most recent Outcome within each screening tool will be counted for each child (i.e. Most recent ASQ-3 Outcome result is where the child will be counted in the ASQ-3 column, most recent PEDS Outcome result is where the child will be counted in the PEDS columns, etc.) and a child will not be counted in multiple Outcome rows.

## **XIII. Referrals to Help Me Grow by Tools:**

---

*This report provides information on status and outcomes for referrals made to Help Me Grow per screening tool.*

**Total number of entries radio dial:** child screenings will be counted in all programs they had a screening. This means that the child may show up in different rows for different screening tools (columns).

**Unique count radio dial:** unique count by column with most recent screening.

## **XIV. Referrals to Other Organization/Programs by Tools:**

---

*This report provides information on the number of referrals to Other Organization/Programs by tools within each program.*

**Total number of entries radio dial:** Total number of referrals made to other organization/programs by tools

**Unique count radio dial:** Counts the total number of referrals made for the most recent screening tool in each column.

There is no outcome information available on these referrals.

## **XV. Screening Results by Child:**

---

*This report provides information on the child's screening results including those entered by other organizations. Rows highlighted in purple indicate a risk result.*

This is a total list report and does not include unique counts.

## **XVI. Summary of Repeat Screenings:**

---

*This report provides information on the number of repeat screenings for each screening tool.*

**First Screening:** counts the first screening per child

**Repeat Screenings:** total number of repeat screenings per child

**Total Screening:** is the number of first screening plus repeat screenings per child
